1. Chair Report

• Item 1: Introduction of Chrissie Costamagna and new committee members

BORP is currently looking for coaching recommendations and is waiting to hear if they have received any wheelchair grants from National.

- Several new initiatives were discussed. Phil proposed an increased wheelchair tennis presence in social media, advertising, flyers, marketing materials with QR codes, and wheelchair tennis demonstrations at able bodied matches, challenger tournament exhibitions.
